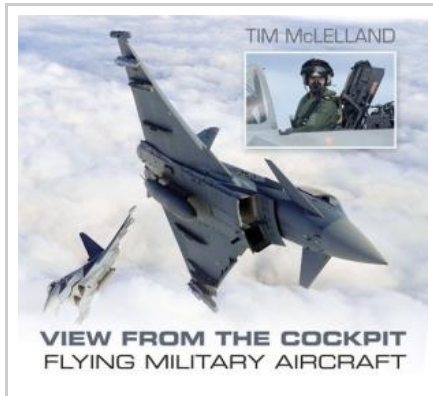




View from the Cockpit: Flying Military Aircraft
