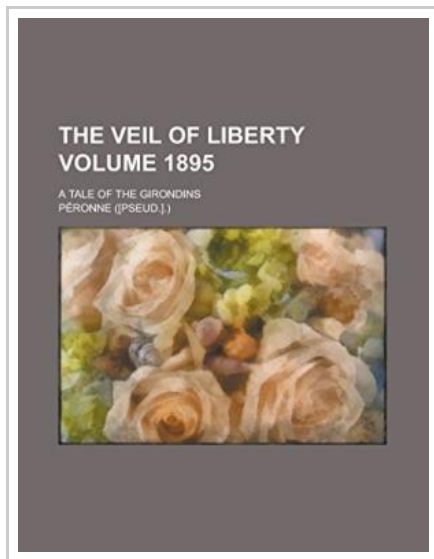




The Veil of Liberty; A Tale of the Girondins Volume 1895 (Paperback)
