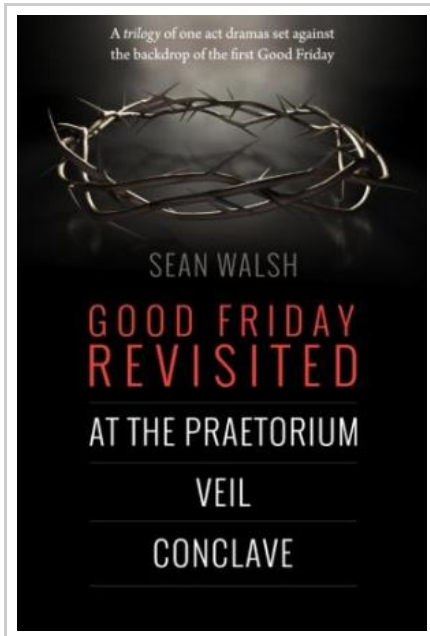




Good Friday Revisited: A Trilogy of Dramas Set Against the Backdrop of the First Good Friday. (Paperback)
